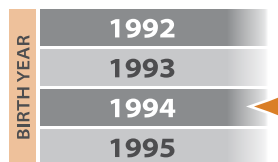

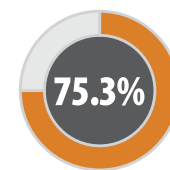

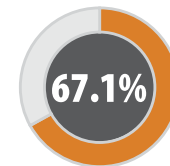

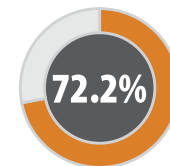

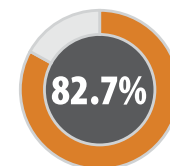

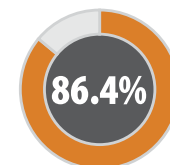

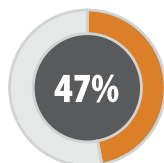

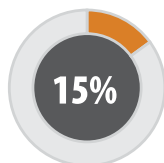

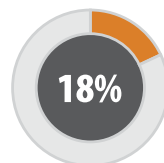
Self-reported reasons why students took the HiSET exam:
